August 9, 1920 - September 3, 2010

Albert Luigi Arcuri, age 90, of Oxford, the beloved husband of 59 years of Hortense Matos Arcuri, entered into rest unexpectedly at his home in Oxford on Friday, September 3, 2010. He was born in Calabria, Italy on August 9, 1920, son of the late Anthony and Josephine Tucci Arcuri. Albert was the founder of the Arcuri Electric Company of Oxford. He was a United States Army Air Corps veteran of World War II, seeing action in the Philippines. During his time in the military, Albert was wrestler. A longtime member of the David S. Miles Post 174 American Legion of Oxford, he also loved building homes, gardening and had a good sense of humor. Albert was a former Constable for the Town of Oxford. He and his wife Hortense also operated the Oxford Post Office for 8 years. Albert was also a member of the Swan Lake Association. He will be sadly missed by his family and many friends.
